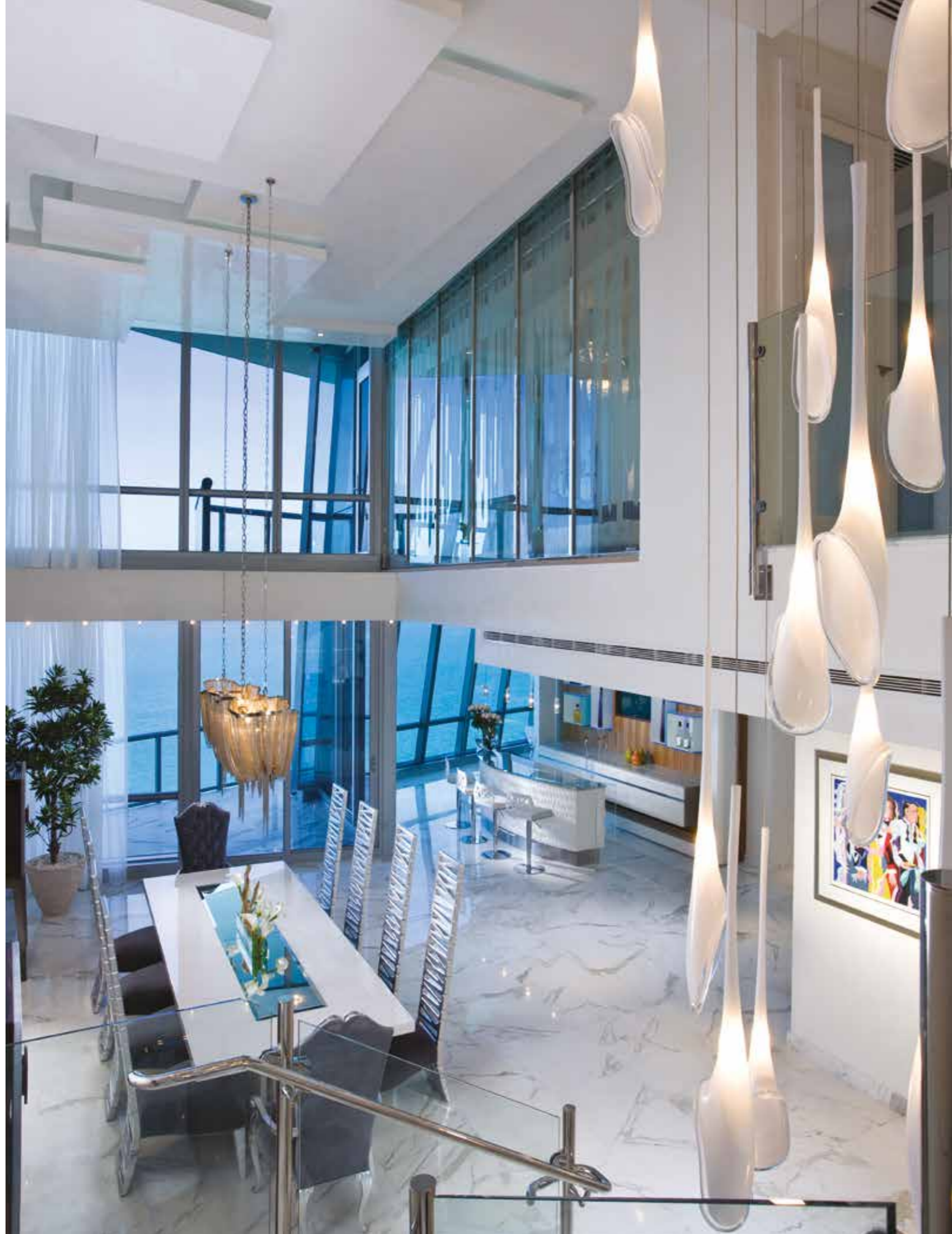
UNEXPECTED DRAMA

An astonishing surprise welcomes anyone who walks into this spacious Miami penthouse.

Complementing the dining space is the chic bar area overlooking the ocean, which was supposed to be the dining room. The quartzite countertops are offset by the walnut insets and custom cabinets for added storage.



Making a great first impression is crucial for Miami-based interior designer Renata Pfuner for it takes only seconds before someone passes a quick judgement. Therefore the private elevator lobby of this 5,150 square-foot Jade Ocean penthouse in Miami is set to make a lasting impression before one even steps into the expansive residence. The imposing vista with white textured walls, mirrored ceiling, elegant chandelier and grand console table is the passage into a world of awe beyond the large front door.

Upon entry, one would be mesmerised by the Artglass International drop chandelier down the stairway, which mimics the shape of a pitcher plant as well as the massive dining area (originally defined to be the living room) at the heart of the home. Visible from virtually every room, stately high-backed chairs with random line design sit on the Calacatta marble flooring and an unusual yet glamorous Atlantis chandelier by Terzani comprised of a canopy of draped chain links make a bold statement in the dining area. To top it off, the double volume ceiling and large mirror embedded into the stone wall further heightens the drama within the space.

With a predominantly white, silver and grey palette used throughout the entire condominium, it was necessary for Renata to inject some colour to appease her clients who come from traditional backgrounds. In doing so, Renata adds warmth to the otherwise sterile space. Maintaining sophistication, the living room is made comfortable with a large area rug, plush white leather sofas tufted in Swarovski crystals and contrasting orange cushions. For added bling, the talented designer installed a pretty chandelier and some ceiling lights that twinkle like stars, coupled with unique ceiling designs.

Accentuating the owners' (Leo and Milena Birov, developers of traditional luxury homes on the North Shore of Chicago) love for traditional design, the white leather tufted bed oozing a Victorian classic look is counterbalanced by



the master bedroom's simple and minimal design. Keeping an all-white palette, the pair of mirrored bedside tables from Neiman Marcus gives a delightful spin to the space. To maximise views and also make the room appear spacious, one of the walls is completely glass, overlooking the dining room.

Likewise, the master bathroom receives similar treatment as the bedroom with slanted glass walls that capitalise on the panoramic ocean view. In fact, almost the entire penthouse is surrounded by glass walls. So, whether the owners are taking a languorous bath in the stand-alone Hydrology bathtub that sits on the interesting mosaic glass tiles or sipping wine by the bar, it would feel like they're on a ship surrounded by the vast ocean.

Having loved traditional designs all their lives, Leo and Milena Birov certainly surprised themselves with an ultra-modern home punctuated with subtle hints of traditional accents. But with Renata shedding the light on them, a modern, glamorous home is undoubtedly as cosy and liveable as a traditional home. ❖
