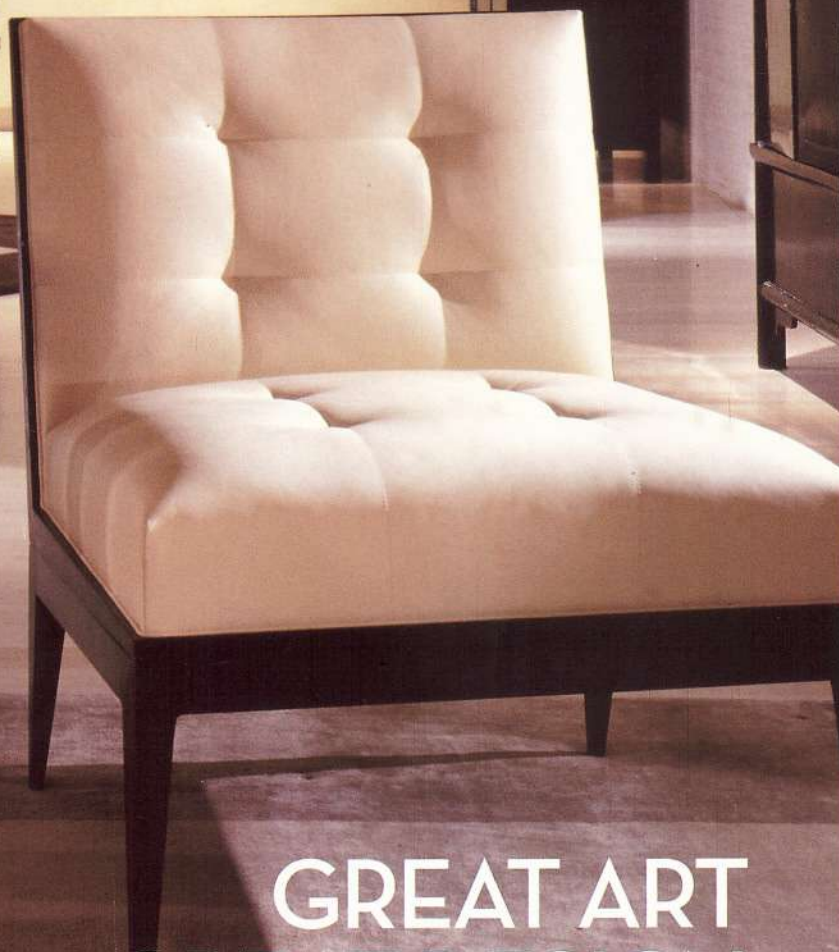

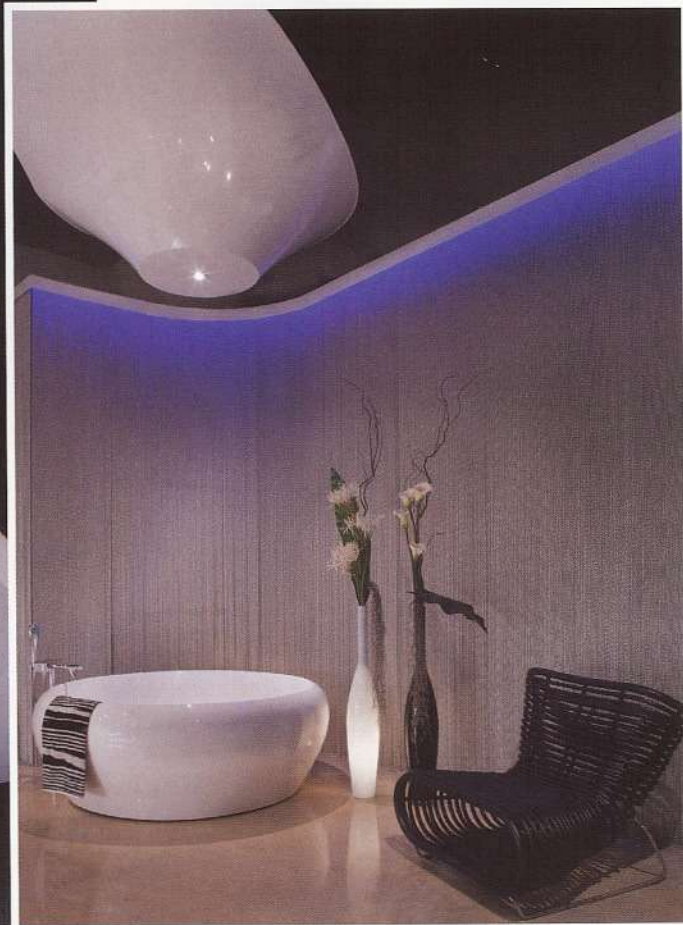

Sponsored by luxury car company Lexus, the Lexus Lifestyle Room was developed by designer Juan Carlos Arcila-Duque, of Arcila-Duque Furniture Interiors, Inc. in Miami Beach. Evoking the sleek minimalist style of the Lexus LS, Arcila-Duque designed a modern space with colors, textures and accessories that create a monochromatic sensibility – chic, contemporary and sophisticated. Here, a table and unique dining chairs from Sipure Design form an interesting vignette, while a vinyl stretch ceiling system from High Tech Ceiling runs from top to bottom.





Interior designers Renata Pfuner and Eduardo Busso, of Pfuner Busso Design, Inc. in Miami, Fla., devised a natural flow for the Liquid Mist bathroom, above and left, using sculptural shapes, reflective surfaces and colorful lighting inspired by the element of water and its role in everyday life. Mixing sleek accents with cool, white fixtures from Vitra USA's Istanbul line, created by Ross Lovegrove, the designers elevated the room to a space that indulges and relaxes. Black, white and silver imbue the area with subdued vitality. Floor vases from Urban Art stand out against a silver chain-link backdrop from BCM, above, while Trend USA's mosaic tiles produce interesting patterns, left, under lacquered lighting from Serralunga.
